EXAMPLE (**from the modeled conversation**):

LINE #3:

CHARLES I: *You should just do what ol' King Henry VIII did when Chancellor Thomas More didn't go to Queen Boleyn's coronation.....murder him! Its not like you are subject to any sort of law or anything. (Sovereignty)*

EXPLANATION: *The featured line connects to the 'sovereignty' aspect of absolutism because Charles I is insinuating that Louis XIV does not have to worry about any sort of punishment or repercussion for murdering someone because he, as an absolute ruler, has the power to **not** be impacted by the laws in which he created. He has the unrestricted power to do things like murder people or start wars without worry about any disagreement from the people working in the government with him.*
